## FACULTY-STAFF SCHOLARSHIP

**Candidates for the Newark Community High School Faculty/Staff Scholarship must meet these criteria.** Qualification is based upon your cumulative grade point average. Eligible seniors must have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or above, or class rank of top 25% ACT score of at least 22. **In addition to the application, you will need to prepare a speech to present to the faculty/staff during school on Friday, February 13, 2026.**

First to complete the application, please save a copy of the scholarship form. Once you have finished completing the form please attach the form to an email addressed to Mr. Lesak (tlesak@nchs18.org) and Mrs. Woods (awoods@nchs18.org). **Your application MUST be completed by 8:00 a.m. Monday, February 9, 2026.** Forms must be completed on time, for your application to be submitted to the staff and for you to make a speech to the group. The winner will be announced at graduation.

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### SPEECH GUIDELINES

**Each student applying for this scholarship must present a 4 - 5 minute speech to the faculty and staff stating:**

- His/her intended major
- Career choices to which the major will lead
- Reasons the student deserves the scholarship
  - Describe Extracurricular activities in schools
  - Describe how you've been actively involved in the community
- A personal assessment of self-values

Prepare your speech as if you are preparing your speech for Senior Seminar. **You should have note cards and practice prior to presenting on Friday, February 13, 2026**

**Please note: This is early dismissal at 1:30 pm.** You must be present for this speech in order to be considered for this scholarship.

**Dress professionally** just like you did for your senior seminar presentation.
